Admission Rules and Policies for New Applicants 2024-2025

Non-Discrimination Policy

We seek diversity in our staff and student body. In the admission and employment policies and practices, in scholarship aid programs, and in all our educational programs, Darul Arqam School does not discriminate on the basis of sex, race, color, religion, or ethnic origin. As a policy, we cannot guarantee admission to any applicant regardless of affiliation with the school.

Mission

Our mission is to provide an excellent Islamic and academic education within an Islamic environment to produce well rounded Muslims and strong leaders. We seek to promote a safe, caring, and supportive environment where our children can attain the knowledge that would enable them to perform as effective citizens of the world, especially in today's world of Globalization. Our students will be attaining such worldly knowledge in a spiritual environment rich with Islamic teachings, values and practices. We strive to have our parents, teachers, and community members actively involved in our students' learning.

Admission Process and Requirements

** Children applying for:

Pre-School must meet minimum age requirements of **3 years** of **age on or before November 30**th **and be potty trained**Pre-K must meet minimum age requirements of **4 years** of **age on or before November 30**th **and be potty trained**Kindergarten must meet minimum age requirements of **5 years** of **age on or before November 30**th

Be aware that if your child does not meet the state's cut off date of Oct. 1st, your child may not be eligible to receive certain accommodations and benefits offered through State and Federal programs. Each township has its own regulations.

- ** We do NOT accept students into 12th grade
- ** No one will be accepted into 9th -11th grades after Oct. 10th

Step 1: Submit the application with the following:

☐ Child's original birth certificate (we will make a copy)	

Step 2: You will receive a call/ email from the administration office with a date and time of the placement test and interview.

Step 3: Take the entrance exam (must pass with an average of at least 70% in each English & Math and attend an interview conducted by the Principal or VP. You will receive an official email and/or call regarding acceptance status. If accepted:

Step 4: Submit the additional forms listed under "Additional Forms Required" section and fees mentioned in the "Tuition Schedule". All new MS/HS parents are required to pay the June tuition after they have been notified via mail of their child's acceptance into the school.

Parent Service Hours:

Darul Arqam School requires each family to provide at least 25 service hours for their child(ren) attending the school. Parents/Guardians who cannot volunteer their time are required to pay \$500.00 (per family). Extra hours you have accumulated may not be 'given' to others. Immediate family members (no other relatives or friends) may contribute their time towards a family's hours.

Smart Tuition:

To facilitate our tuition collection the school uses Smart Tuition. Smart Tuition offers live telephone support to parents 24 hours a day, 7 days a week. Parents will be charged a **\$50 annual fee** at the beginning of the school year to use this service.

Tuition Collection / Late Fee:

Tuition is paid over a **ten-month period** (September - June). All tuition payments must be made via Smart Tuition either by check, money order, credit card or automatic debit. **No payments will be accepted in the office**. Monthly payments must be received by the 5th of each month to avoid incurring late fees. <u>Please note that the late fees are charged by Smart Tuition</u>, the school does not receive any portion of the late fees nor are we able to deduct them from an account <u>without having to pay it ourselves</u>. For any tuition payments made after the due date Smart Tuition will automatically apply a **NON-REFUNDABLE \$45.00 late** fee and same for **returned checks**. The school will not be held responsible for any acquired late fees.

inancial Aid

Students enrolled in Grades 1 through 12 are eligible to apply for Financial Aid. Financial Aid is on a first come, first served basis and is to be approved by the Board of Trustees. Application Deadline July 30th. If you are interested in applying for FA, please ask the office for the link. **Students receiving FA with excessive and/or repetitive behavior infractions are subject to having FA taken away at any time during the school year.**

Acceptance of School Polices:

I agree to pay tuition and other fees as outlined above and to the acceptance of all school policies outlined above and in the Parent/Student Handbook. Parents initiating withdrawal after 4 academic months of school are required to pay the full year's tuition. Withdrawal prior to 4 academic months, half of the annual tuition must be paid. No records, transcripts, or report cards will be made available to transferring institutions or parents until financial obligations have been fulfilled. The school reserves the right to increase tuition and inform parents during the year, the increase will not be more than 10%.
